Berl Grant Receives FAA Master Pilot Award

The FAA's Wright Brothers Master Pilot award recognizes pilots who have achieved 50 years of safe flight as Pilot In Command. Your editor learned earlier this year that Berl met all the qualifications and applied for the award on his behalf. Since it came through just before Oshkosh we decided to present it there. The presentation was made in the International Comanche Society tent on Monday, July 20th.
